JUNIOR NATIONAL TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019 GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- a) Player must be a national of Great Britain;
- b) Player **must not** have competed in another closed national championship in the 12 months preceding the Junior National Tennis Championships;
- c) Player must not have previously represented any other nation in the Davis Cup or Federation Cup or the Olympic tennis event; and
- d) Player must be a British Tennis member.

Once the acceptances have been published players will be asked to provide proof of Nationality and date of birth. More details will be sent to the relevant players.

HOW TO ENTER SINGLES & DOUBLES

- The competition opens for entry on Thursday 4 July 2018 and the entry deadline is 10:00 Friday 2 August 2019.
- Players can only enter online, via the competition search on the <u>LTA website</u>, into the relevant singles tournament code before the closing date (12U DOR19S1175, 14U, 16U 18U NOT19S1176). See below for the doubles entry process.
- Once a player has entered the competition he/she **must** ensure that his/her name appears on the entry list before the entry deadline in order to be considered.
- Singles entry fee £27, payment will be taken during the online entry process.
- Doubles entry fee £10 per player in each pair, payment will be taken on-site at the time of entry.
 Players will not be placed in the doubles draw unless their entry fee has been received.
- 14U & 16U players may enter & compete in 2 singles & 1 doubles during the same week.
- Players can only compete in one doubles event.
- Entry into doubles events will be via an on-site/telephone sign-in at the tournament on **the first day of the singles event** for the relevant age group. The entry deadline will be 12:00 noon on that day.
- Players should check their British Tennis Membership (BTM) contact details are up to date as these will be used to send any communication
- If you are experiencing problems entering online please contact the Tournament Director at Nationaltour@LTA.org.uk or on 020 8487 7000, **BEFORE** the entry deadline. The date and time of the email / telephone call will be considered in any entry disputes. Nothing can be done if no contact has been made before the entry deadline.

ENTRY VIA THE SUMMER NATIONAL TOUR LEADERBOARD

At the end of the 2019 Summer National Tour circuit there will be, in the 12U – 18U age groups, 2 places in the main draw reserved for the top 2 players in the Summer National Tour Leaderboard who have not already been accepted into the National Championships.

To be eligible for the SNT link space players must:

- 1. Have entered the relevant age group in the Junior National Tennis Championships before the entry deadline.
- 2. Still meet the eligibility criteria as set out in regulations 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Junior National Tennis Championships regulations.

The SNT linked space will be allocated at the same time as the players who gain direct acceptances.

WILD CARDS

Wild cards places are spaces in the draw reserved for players who have entered, but would not be accepted through the stated acceptance criteria.

 Only entered players will be considered for wild cards and their request for a wild card can only be in relation to injury/illness. The LTA wild card policy is being updated and will soon be posted online.



- Wild card requests must be received by the entry deadline on a wild card application form which in found on the LTA website on the entry page for the National Championships.
- The number of wild cards per draw is detailed in the Tournament Regulations section 21.
- Wild cards for singles events will be published by the end of Tuesday 6 August 2019. Any wild card spaces not used will be released at the same time and the next eligible reserve will move up accordingly.

LATE ENTRIES

- A late entry may not be accepted if he/she would be seeded at the time of making the late entry.
- Late entries will only be accepted if the event is under-subscribed and there are places available on the reserve list.
- Late entries will join the bottom of the reserve list, in order of receipt.
- Should a late entry move to the top of the reserve list **before** the draw is made and a place becomes available, he/she can be accepted into the event, even though at that point, he/she could be seeded.
- After the draw has been made, a late entrant may not be accepted into the event if he/she moves to the top of the reserve list and would be seeded.

PUBLICATION OF ENTRY LISTS

The acceptance list will be published on the closing deadline. This will include the 26 direct acceptances as well as the 2 players who have gained entry from the SNT Leaderboard. The wild card information will follow a few days later after consideration by the Performance Team.
