How to enter online?

Key points before entry:

- You have a shared venue login/password - don't change the password.
- Payment is required online at the time of entry. Your entry will not be accepted without payment
- 8\&U-18\&U (junior) entries must note the ratings of players (not names) in their team
- From 1 January 2019, Open (adult) teams can view the Open promotion/relegation structure online (in the Rules, Regulations \& Resources section) to understand their position

|  | There will be TWO options but it is important that Clubs enter the correct division to <br> ensure that players get a positive experience. <br> Division 1 will be a traditional league aimed at all RED players but should be for players <br> with some competition experience. Each team will consist of 4 players and matches will <br> consist of 16 singles as outlined in the captain's guide. <br> Division 2 will be for smaller clubs and players with little or no competition experience and <br> be run on a regional Central Venue League basis on one day. (Formerly these players <br> would have ratings of R4 and R3).The team of 4 will play 1 match against their opposite <br> number in each opposing team. Division 1 players are excluded from CVL. |
| Mixed 9\&U | 9\&U events will have consist of two different league options. <br> Division 1 will be for teams of 4 players with each match consisting of 8 singles and 2 |

| Mixed 10\&U | 10\&U events will have consist of two different league options. <br> Division 1 will be for teams of 4 players with each match consisting of 4 singles and 2 doubles. <br> Division 2 is for smaller clubs with teams of 2 players with a ratings cap of G2, G3 and G4 ONLY and a match shall consist of each member playing 1 singles and 1 doubles. |
| Girls 12\&U, 14\&U, 16\&U and 18\&U | Division 1 will be for teams of 4 players with each member playing 1 singles and 1 doubles match. <br> Division 2 is for smaller clubs with teams of 2 players and there will be a ratings cap of 8.1. Each person will play 1 singles and 1 doubles match. Note that the ratings cap has been raised for girls ONLY. |
| Boys 12\&U, 14\&U, 16\&U and 18\&U | Division 1 will be for teams of 4 players with each member playing 1 singles and 1 doubles match. <br> Division 2 is for smaller clubs with teams of 2 players and there will be a ratings cap of 8.2. Each person will play 1 singles and 1 doubles match. |
| Women's Open | This event is for teams of 4 players each person playing 1 singles and 1 doubles match. Should there be sufficient entries there may be 2 divisions created on known form. |
| Men's Open | This event is for teams of 4 players each person playing 1 singles and 1 doubles match. There will be 2 divisions ( 1 A and 1 B ) and teams should indicate their preference on the entry form. |
