# WHAT IS THE NATIONAL LEAGUE?

This is a **NEW** team competition for all LTA registered venues taking place throughout the winter months. Team competition is a great way for players to play tennis in a fun, sociable and competitive environment. There is a strong desire for more team competition, and this has been brought in to complement already existing county leagues or to fill gaps within the competition calendar.

## ELIGIBILITY, EVENTS & FORMAT

A player may represent one venue in the competition

Mixed 8U – for players born 1 April 2011 or later

Mixed 9U – for players born 1 April 2010 – 31 March 2011

Mixed 10U – for players born 1 April 2009 – 31 March 2010

Boys/Girls 12U – for players born 1 April 2007 – 31 March 2009

Boys/Girls 14U – for players born 1 April 2005 – 31 March 2009

Boys/Girls 16U – for players born 1 April 2003 – 31 March 2009

Boys/Girls 18U – for players born 1 April 2001 – 31 March 2009

## COMPETITION DATES

Matches are to be played on fixed dates to help teams plan their player and court availability in advance. There will be flexibility to play before a match date if both teams agree. All match dates for all age groups can be viewed online
