

Talent Cymru Funding Criteria 2019



GENERAL INFORMATION	Players meeting at least ONE of the minimum criteria below in the previous 12 months will be CONSIDERED for Talent Cymru funding:
TALENT	Moving into U13 Internationally: U12 Top 10 in GB Domestic Rankings (according to international birth year), Attended National Camp, Represented GB in Age Group event, U12 TE SF or better in singles, Domestic Grade 1 or 2 SF or better in singles. Moving into U14 Internationally: U13 Top 10 in GB Domestic Rankings (according to international birth year), Attended National Camp, Represent GB in Age Group event, Top 300 TE U14 ranking, U14 TE QF or better in singles, Domestic Grade 1 or 2 SF or better in singles, Talent Cyrnru funded in previous year. Moving into U15 Internationally: U14 Top 10 in GB Domestic Rankings (according to international birth year), Attended National Camp, Represented GB in Age Group event, Top 100 TE U14 ranking, U14 TE SF or better in singles, Domestic Grade 1 or 2 SF or better in singles, Talent Cyrnru funded in previous year. Moving into U16 Internationally: U15 Top 10 in GB Domestic Rankings (according to international birth year), Attended National Camp, Represented GB in Age Group event, U18 ITF Ranking from singles points, Domestic Grade 1 or 2 SF or better in singles, Talent Cyrnru funded in previous year. Moving into U17 Internationally: U16 Top 10 in GB Domestic Rankings (according to international birth year), Attended National Camp, Represented GB in Age Group event, Top 1000 U18 ITF Ranking, U18 ITF QF or better in singles, Domestic Grade 1 or 2 SF or better in singles, Talent Cyrnru funded in previous year. Moving to U18 Internationally: U17 Top 10 in GB Domestic Rankings (according to international birth year), Attended National Camp, Represented GB in Age Group event, ITF World Tour singles ranking, Top 500 U18 ITF Ranking, U18 ITF SF or better in singles, Domestic Grade 1 or 2 SF or better in singles, Talent Cyrnru funded in previous year.
TOURNAMENT GRANTS	Tournament grant application system for players to request financial support towards international tournaments. Players need to have been invited to apply for Elite Cymru or Talent Cymru. Selections will then be based on the relevance of the event and it's context within a credible quarterly competition schedule.
