Mini Tennis Acceptance and Seeding Criteria

Acceptance

For 9U (Orange) and 10U (Green) tournaments grade 1 to grade 5 acceptances will be based on the following criteria using the information available at the closing deadline of the competition:

- 1. Qualifiers from linked tournaments
- Wild cards. These will be awarded up to a maximum of 1 wild card for every 4 places in the draw size and decided by the Organising Committee including a County/National Association Representative (usually the Regional Tennis Performance Co-ordinator).
- 3. Mini Tennis Rating
- 4. Recent Form which is the player's best individual tournament performance at that ball colour within the last 3 months
- 5. By lot

Seeding

For 9U (Orange) and 10U (Green) tournaments grade 1 to grade 5 seeding will be based on the following criteria using the information available at the withdrawal deadline:

- 1. Mini Tennis Rating
- 2. Recent Form which is the player's best individual tournament performance at that ball colour within the last 3 months
- 3. By lot



Recent Form Example

Draycott Orange Tournament (Grade 4) is an 8 player draw. Both Sophie and Lauren have an Orange 2 rating and would like the last place in the draw.

The Referee/Organiser will look at Sophie and Laurens best result at Orange Ball over the last 3 months.

Sophie's Best Results

Quarter Final Tipton Grade 3 (100 points)

Lauren's Best Results

Runner-Up Shrewsbury Grade 4 (75 points)

Sophie's recent form is better therefore she will get the last place in the draw.

If Recent Form is equal then draw by lot.
