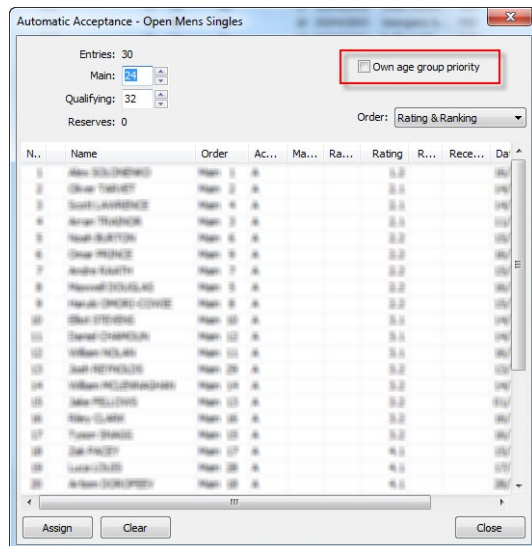

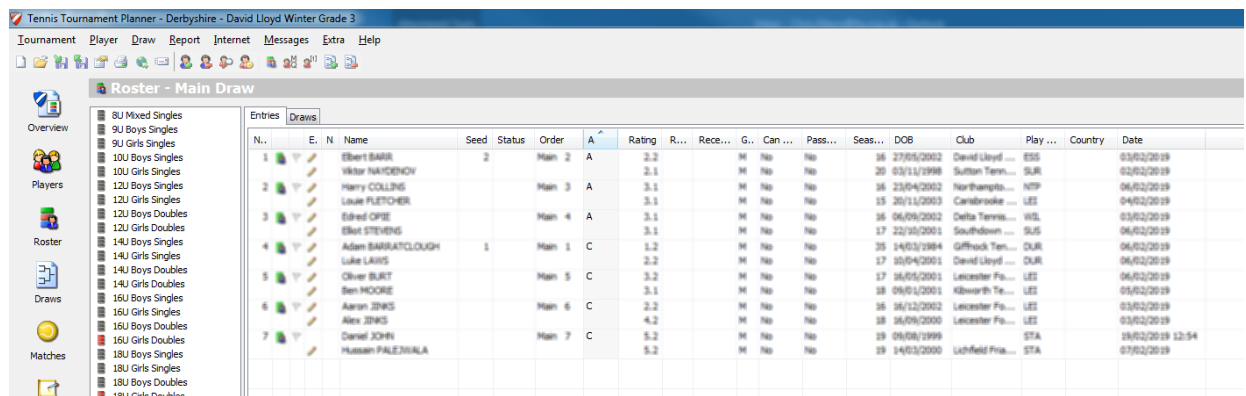

The following changes have been made to TTP in this release:

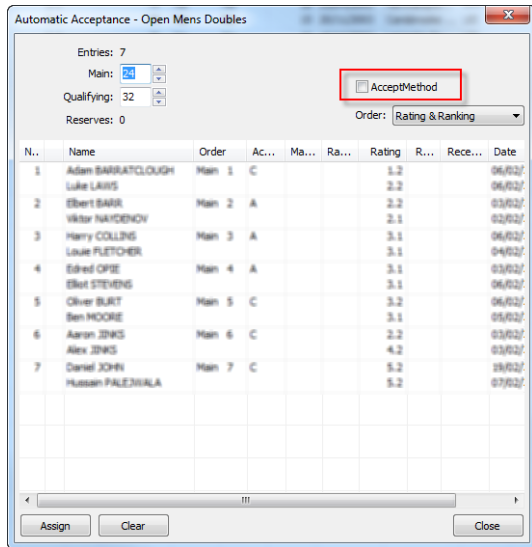
- A new Own Age Group Priority tick box has been added to Automatic Acceptance to prioritise those over 19 in open events, if approved by the CDP.



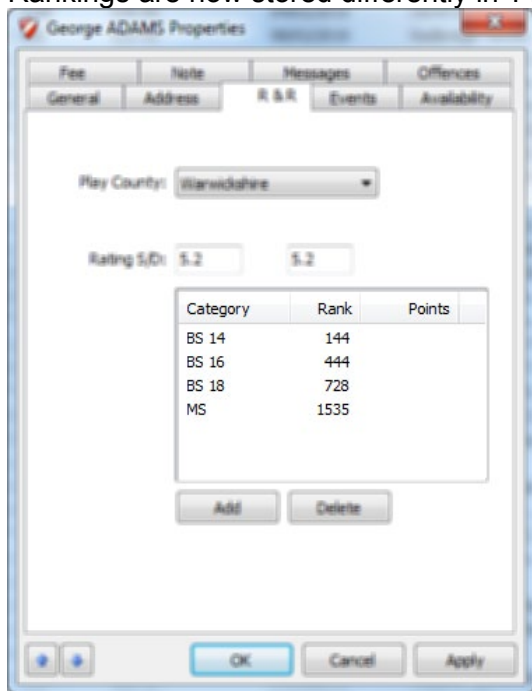
- A new Acceptance Method column has been created which for singles will show an A for all players. For doubles it calculates the priority order:
  - 2 players in same age group singles main draw
  - 1 player in same age group singles main draw and 1 player in another age group singles main draw
  - 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 reserve or non-entered singles player
  - 2 reserve or non-entered singles players



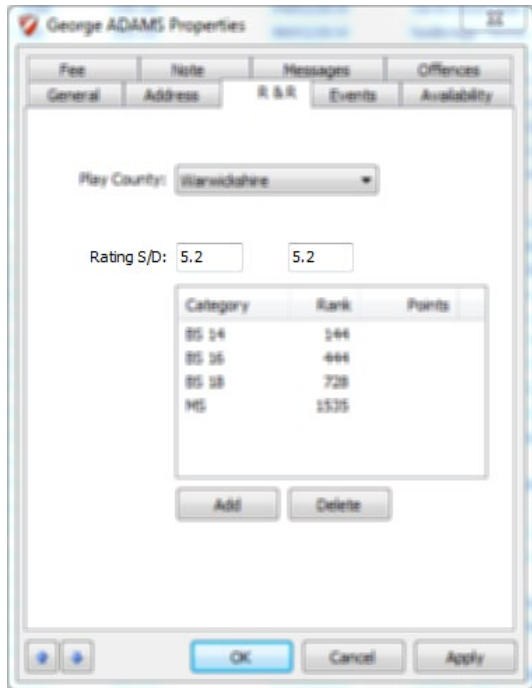
- A new Accept Method tick box will show when using the Automatic Acceptance feature in a doubles event to take into account the priority order.



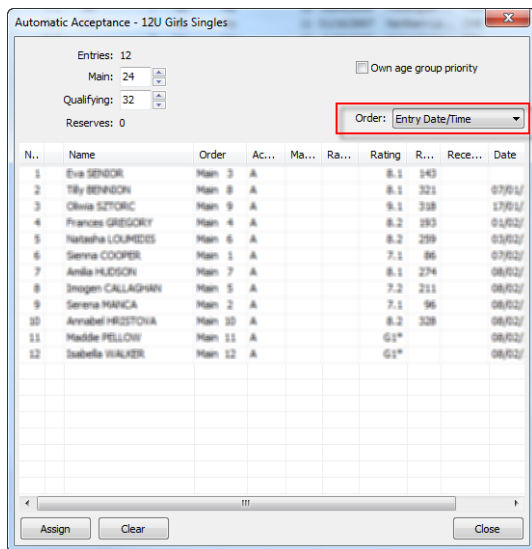
- Rankings are now stored differently in TTP.



- The British Tennis Rating now shows in both the Singles & Doubles Rating fields on the Player Properties and can be seen in the Doubles Roster.



- Entry Time now pulls through to TTP
- New Acceptance Order of Entry Date/Time to support LTA pilot

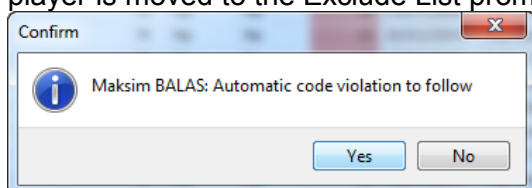

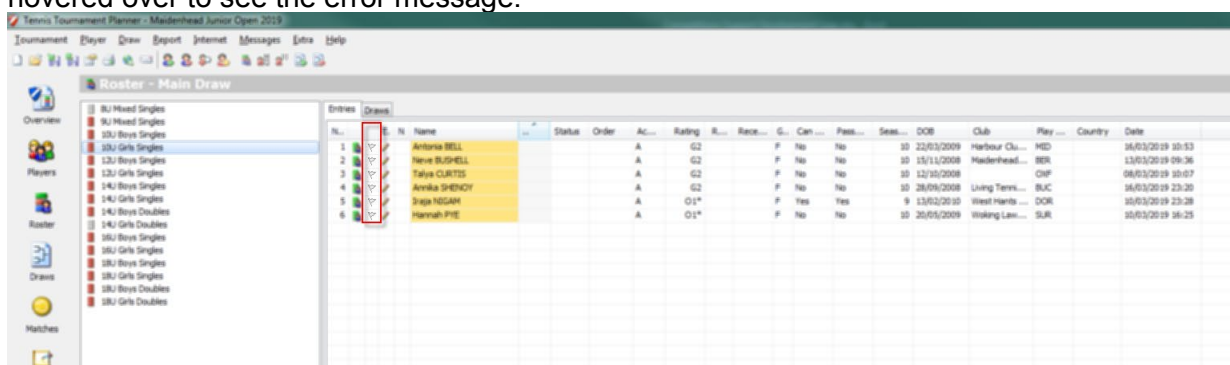

The following changes have been made to TTP in this release:

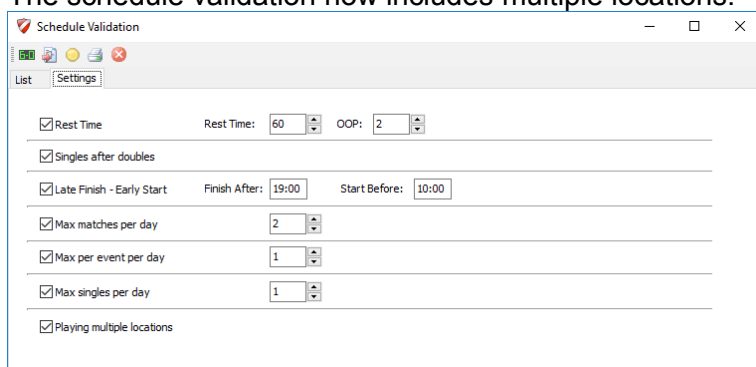
- 2019 Licenses issued.
- Fix to Scheduling which created an Access Violation Error Message.
- Introduction of a Withdrawal Offence pop up when the withdrawal deadline has passed and a player is moved to the Exclude List prompting a user to record a withdrawal offence:



- Entry Validation now shows in the roster showing if a player is contravening any entry rules. Red errors are critical and should be acted upon, amber warnings are advisory. These can be hovered over to see the error message.



- The schedule validation now includes multiple locations.



- The order of player view can show a match information panel with other matches and locations for the selected players by selecting the Show Info Panel

- The 'not-warned' window (Player → Not Warned) includes a player search and shows more information. Also a filter has been added.
- The schedule settings have been moved from Program Options to tournament properties.
