(If these wild cards are not required or accepted the wild card will go back to the LTA Performance Team)</p> <p>1 discretionary wild card from the LTA Performance Team *</p> <p>Acceptance criteria will be in order of WTA/ATP ranking, followed by ITF World Tennis ranking of 1500 or better, on 17 June.</p> <p>Players without a WTA/ATP ranking or ITF World Tennis ranking of 1500 or better will be ordered according to LTA rating (followed by LTA Open ranking where same rating) on 17 June.</p> <p>A player may request to use a protected WTA/ATP ranking for acceptance only (this request must be made when signing in).</p> <p>The final two players from each of the men's and women's events will be guaranteed wild cards into the Wimbledon Qualifying competition.</p> <p>* The LTA Performance Team will retain the right to award one wild card in line with their Wild Card policy. If this wild card will be awarded, the LTA Performance Team will make their decision one week before the sign in, with the player in question being notified. If this wild card isn't awarded at this time, it will go to the next highest ranked player on the ATP / WTA ranking, followed by ITF World Tennis ranking of 1500 or better at the time of the sign in. BALL CHANGE	7 / 9 (6 balls in play)
CLOTHING & FOOTWEAR	Players are required to wear almost entirely white recognised tennis clothing. Tennis shoes must conform to the Official Grand Slam Rule Book 2019.
COMPETITOR / GUEST PASSES	Available from the Referee's Office in Aorangi Park – these must be worn at all times whilst on-site and are non-transferable. Where possible please notify the Tournament Director in advance of names for coach/guest passes.
ACCESS TO GROUNDS	Pedestrian access to Aorangi Park via Gate 1 (Church Road) from Southfields. Additional access available at Gates 19 and 20.
CAR PARK	Gate 20 for Car Park 4 (Somerset Road) to be used.
SPECTATORS	Please note that this event is not open to the general public.
TRAVEL DIRECTIONS By Car	M25 to Junction 10. Take A3 towards London. Leave A3 where signposted to Wimbledon Village. Left at mini roundabout, signposted to Wimbledon Village. Follow this road, past Westside Tennis Club. Across mini-roundabout and follow road to Wimbledon Village. Left at roundabout into High Street and then right at mini-roundabout. At next mini-roundabout, take 2 nd exit into Church Road. Take first road on left (Somerset Road) and Car Park 4 is along this road, on the right hand side.
By Rail	Train to Wimbledon and then tube to Southfields.
By Tube	Nearest underground station is Southfields. From the tube station, cross the road towards Nat West Bank and follow Wimbledon Park Road to AELTC.
