Player Grants for Overseas Tournaments for players 14+

Introduction

There may be certain circumstances where a player grant is awarded for overseas travel for players 14+ on the National Age Group Programme (NAGP) or over 21 who are not on the Pro Scholarship Programme (PSP) but who are demonstrating the potential to reach the PSP criteria before they turn 24. In this instance the following process will be followed.

Selection Process

- To be eligible for a grant you must be eligible to represent Great Britain in Davis or Fed Cup.
- There will be a quarterly meeting chaired by the Head of Pro Tour Pathway with the Head of Men's / Women's Tennis (or their nominee).
- The Head of Men's / Women's Tennis will submit to the Head of Pro Tour Pathway, in advance of the meeting, the players to be considered for that quarter based on their results/performances and who are demonstrating the potential to reach the PSP criteria before they turn 24.
- In this meeting the performance of the proposed players will be considered along with attributes linked to Heart, Legs and Game Development.
- The panel will consider making travel grants to those players who are making progress which suggests they are on track to meet the published PSP shortlisting criteria by the end of the year and there is budget available.
- Grants will be awarded at the discretion of the panel.
